- 6 Joey was a good artist.

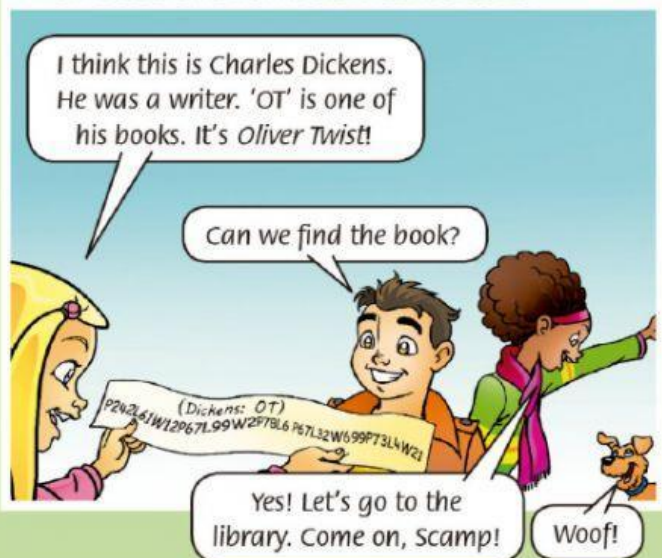


The police were sure he was the robber.
