SIMPLE PRESENT Talking about routine/habits, facts, truth

Example: I play soccer on Saturdays.

Use (s, es) for he, she, it

They study English daily.

Note use (s) and (es) only in the present simple.

POSITIVE She listen to the radio while I drive.

Then use (es) with verbs ending in (sh, ch, x, s, z)

The teacher helps the students.

He washes his car every month.

CONTRACTION

Do not = don't

NEGATIVE He doesn't cook dinner for his family.

Does not = doesn't

The teacher does not work on weekends.
