CONTINUOUS**

Talking about a near future action, something happening now or something not finished.

Example:

I am playing soccer.

They are studying English.

POSITIVE

She is listening to the radio.

The teacher is helping the students.

He is washing his car.

AM = I

He

IS = She

It

You

Are = They
