

UNIT 6 GRAMMAR – Comparative – Long Adjectives



REMEMBER

1. Two-syllable adjectives: **MORE + ADJECTIVE + THAN**

Example: careful – **more careful**

He is a more careful driver than his brother.

modern – **more modern**

Our new house is more modern than our old one.

Special:

- Two-syllable adjectives end with -y: y-> i + er
happy – **happier**
ugly - **uglier**
- Two-syllable adjectives end with -er / -le / -or /-ow: **Adj + er**
simple – **simpler**
clever – **cleverer (sometimes – more clever)**
narrow – **narrower**

2. Three or more syllable adjectives: **MORE + ADJECTIVE + THAN**

Example: expensive – **more expensive**

iPhone is more expensive than Samsung phone.

important – **more important**

Getting exercise is more important than watching TV.

3. Irregular adjectives:

Adjectives	Comparative
good	better
bad	worse
far	farther
