- ❖ base form + **d/ ed**
(**liked**, **baked**, **decided**, **baked**, etc.)

He **baked** the cake **yesterday**.
(**added**, **listened**, **whirred**, etc.)

He **helped** me **yesterday**.

- ❖  **last week**
- ❖  **last year**
- ❖  **when I was**
- ❖  **two weeks ago**
- ❖  **in September**
- ❖  **in 2019**
