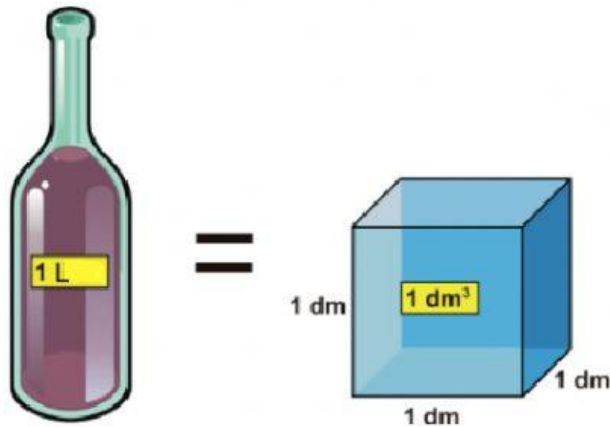


CONNECTION BETWEEN CAPACITY (L) AND VOLUME (m³) - II
