

PRONOUNCING [ə]

It is difficult to hear the difference between [æ] and [ə] when these sounds are produced in isolation. However, [ə] is produced with much less force and occurs only in unstressed syllables.

Possible Pronunciation Problems

[ə] does not exist in most languages. The position of the lips and jaw is the same as for [æ], but the tongue muscles are completely relaxed. [ə] never receives strong emphasis and is found only in unstressed syllables.

The vowel [ə] does not occur at the beginning of words.

[ə] Spelled

note

The major spellings of [ə] are *ar*, *er*, and *or* when the sound occurs in the middle or at the ends of words.
