YOUNG BOY SAVES MAN'S LIFE

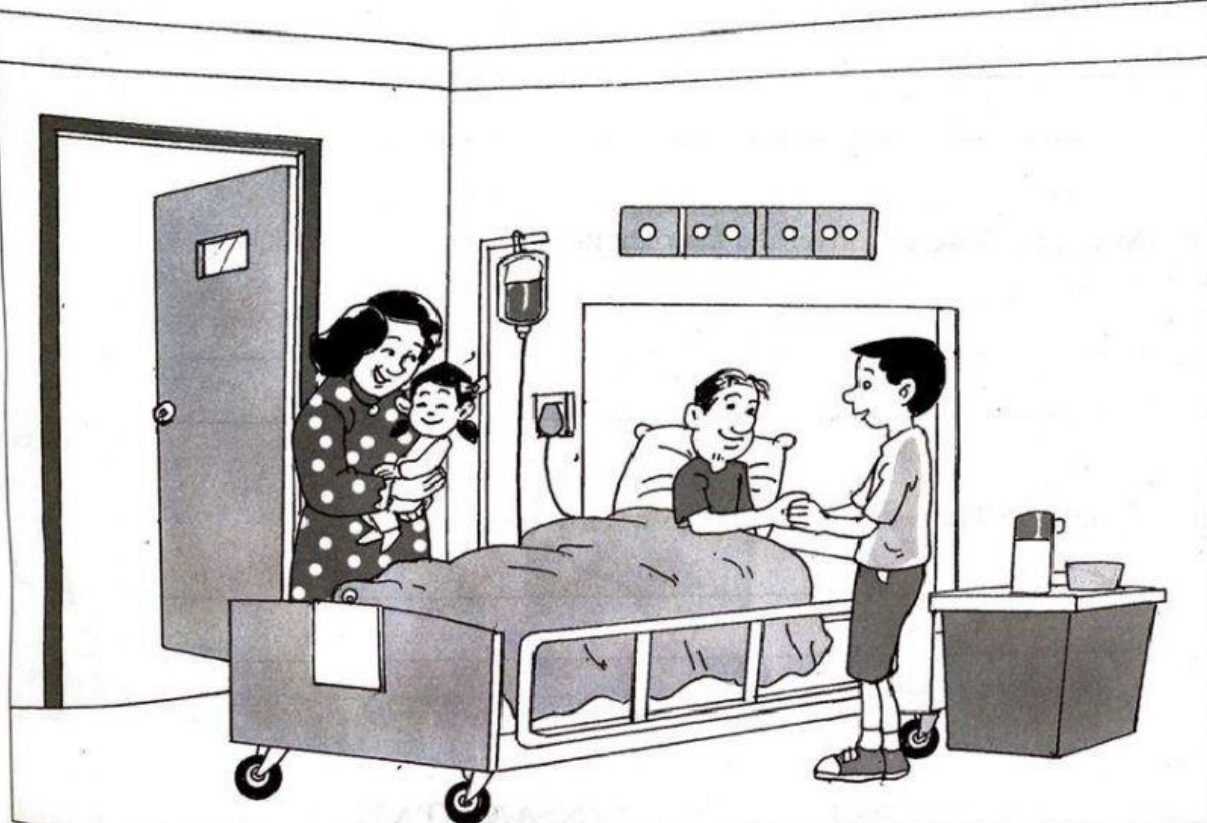
Melaka: Swift action by Tan Wen Ming, 12, saved the life of a man yesterday.
