
Use these rules to **round** Fractions

When the numerator is:			Round to:	
much less than the denominator			0	
about $\frac{1}{2}$ the denominator			1 2	
about the same as the denominator			1	


Use benchmark fractions such as $0, \frac{1}{2}$, or 1 to round off the given fractions.

Select the correct bench mark fraction that each given fraction should round off to.


A Number line can make it easy to decide which benchmark fraction it is closet to





