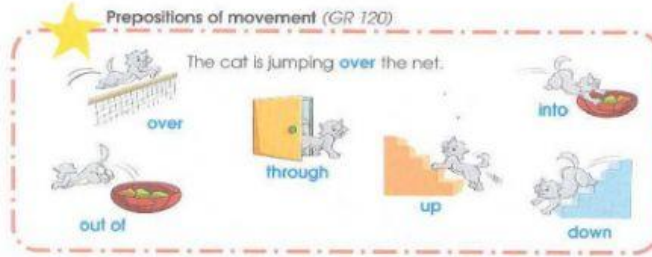


Prepositions of movement (GR 120)

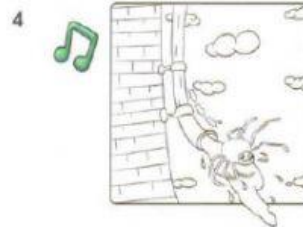

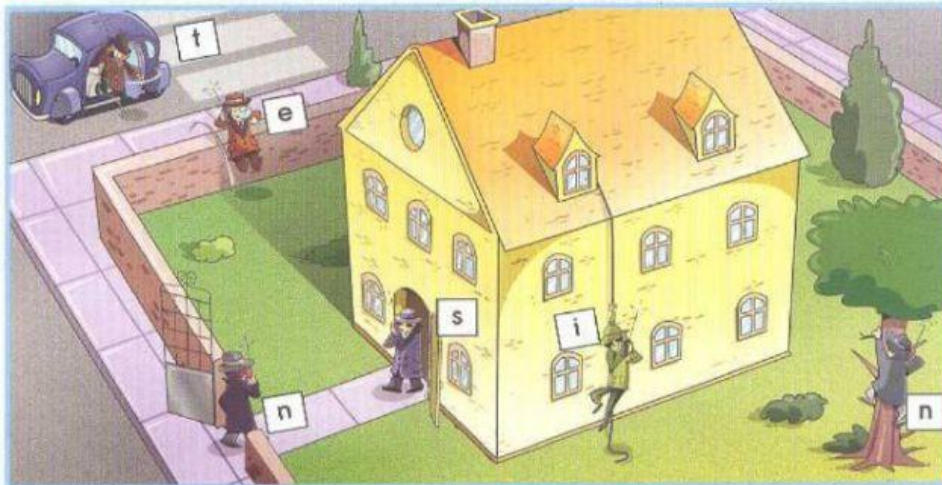
