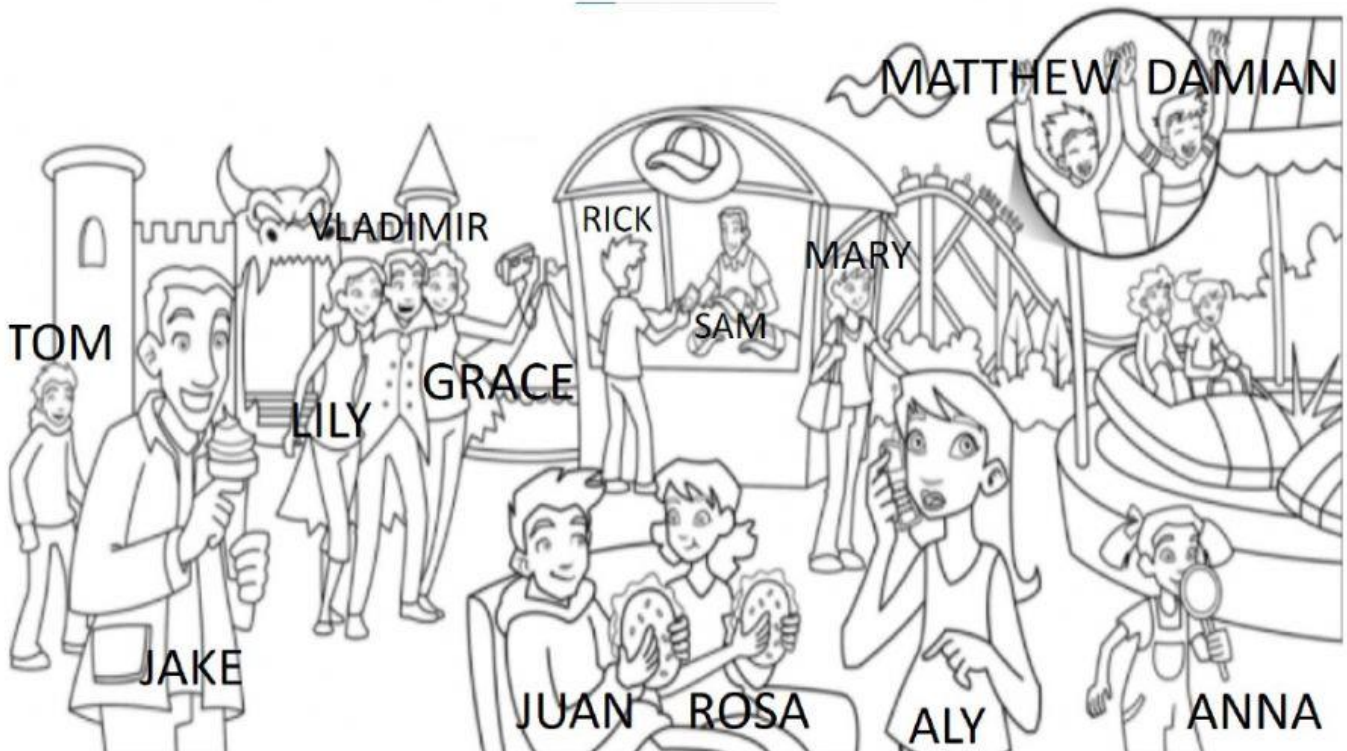

The Olympic Games

The Olympic Games take their name from ancient Greek legend. The Greek god Zeus fought against a god named Kronos on a high mountain, and he won. At the bottom of the mountain, people built a temple to celebrate Zeus's victory. They named this place Olympia. The first Olympic Games took place in Olympia in 776 BC. The only competition was a race. After a hundred years, they added other sports like boxing and jumping. Only men and boys

watched and participated in the Olympic Games. After many years, the Romans came to Greece and stopped the Olympic Games. The first modern Olympic Games took place in 1896. It included many original Olympic sports and new sports, too. People from all nations, men and women, could participate. The Olympic Games occur every four years, in a different city each time. Winners for each sport receive a gold, silver or bronze medal.
