SUBJECT	AUXILIARY	VERB IN "PAST ARTICIPLE"
I	have (+)	<u>taken</u> French lessons.
YOU		
WE	haven't (-)	<u>worked</u> for that company for 3 years.
THEY		<u>gone</u> to the shopping center.
HE	has (+)	<u>seen</u> that movie.

IT	hasn't (-)	<u>played</u> the piano since 2015.
