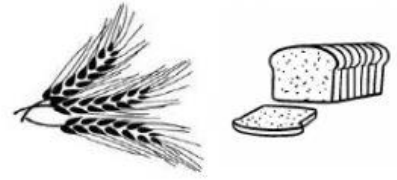


## THE PASSIVE...

Often, **S** **V** **O**  
people eat bread with every meal.



Often, **O»S** **BE** **P.PART**  
bread is\* eaten with every meal.

\*eat = present simple so BE has to be in present simple as well (=is)

Bread is a very popular food. Often, it is eaten (eat) with every meal.

But where does it come from and how \_\_\_\_\_(make)?

Usually, bread \_\_\_\_\_ (make) from wheat, which \_\_\_\_\_  
(grow) in a field.

When the wheat is ripe, it \_\_\_\_\_(harvest). Then it  
\_\_\_\_\_ (take) to the flour mill. At the mill, it \_\_\_\_\_(grind)  
into flour.

At a factory, the flour \_\_\_\_\_(mix) with salt, water and yeast to make  
dough. When the dough has risen, it \_\_\_\_\_(cut) into pieces and the  
pieces \_\_\_\_\_(shape) into loaves. The loaves \_\_\_\_\_(put) on  
trays and then they \_\_\_\_\_(put) in the oven to bake. After about an  
hour, the bread \_\_\_\_\_(take) out of the oven and it \_\_\_\_\_  
(leave) to cool. Then, the bread \_\_\_\_\_(slice) by a machine and it  
\_\_\_\_\_ (put) into plastic bags.

Finally, the bread \_\_\_\_\_(deliver) to the shop where it  
\_\_\_\_\_ (sell) to customers.
