Should Children Wear Uniform?

August is a time when British parents think about **1 buying/giving** school uniform. But does school uniform **2 pay/cost** too much?

UK parents spend about £134 on school uniform and **3 shoes/glasses**. There are **4 prettier/cheaper** options but schools want students to wear **5 bags/clothes** with their logo. These items can be more expensive.

But is school uniform really **6 interesting/necessary**? In most UK schools students have to wear uniform but teachers and parents have **7 no/different opinions**.

Kate, a teacher from Essex, said uniform gives children "a sense of **8 fashion/identity**". She said they felt like they belonged to a school if they wore uniform.

Claire, a parent and teacher, says uniform is great because it's harder to tell who cannot afford **9 expensive brands/cheap clothes**.

Others think that children should wear what makes them feel **10 comfortable/elegant**.

School uniform has quite a long **11 history/destiny**. Christ's Hospital School in England believes its uniform comes from the 16th century.

The school was created by Edward VI, a Tudor king, who **12 died/reigned** from 1547 until 1553.



From 1870, during the Victorian period, every child had to go to school. At this time, many school children wore uniforms.
