


PUNCTUATION MARKS



Punctuation marks are used to tell what kind of sentence we are making, or what we are trying to say.

Don't forget!

- A sentence always starts with a **CAPITAL letter** and ends with a **punctuation mark**.
- The pronoun "I" is always a **CAPITAL letter**.

A question mark is used to ask a question	An exclamation mark shows strong emotion.	A full stop mark shows that a statement has ended.
