SOUTH MALLING LEISURE CENTRE

The centre was opened by Major Eleanor Wise last Friday and opens its door to the public this week with many special offers this month for anyone taking out a year's membership.

Our Olympic-size swimming pool is the only one in the city. Come and experience long-distance swimming in our modern ozone pool. We have fully-qualified lifeguards on duty throughout the day and trainers available for those who would like to learn to swim or improve their current technique. The pool is open from 6-8am for early swimmers and then 4-10pm Monday-Friday. Other times are reserved for schools and club swims. We provide a range of swimming aid for children, such as rubber rings and armbands, and for training purposes, we provide flippers and pull-buoys. All lanes are open to the public at the weekends from 9am-9pm. Pool Membership for a year will give you



unlimited access to the facilities during the year and one free session with a trainer.

The gym can be found on the first floor. It is in an attractive pine studio with large plate glass windows looking out onto the nearby forest. Headphones and a selection of themed music stations to suit all tastes are available on our treadmills, rowing machines and stationary bicycles. Our weight room staff are ready and eager to help you choose a training programme for the session and give you advice on your lifting technique. We will soon be running cross-fit session on Wednesday evenings so sign up now as the number of places is limited. The whole gym can be booked for office team-building days and equipment can be synchronized to enable exercise with a competitive edge. Annual Gym Membership cardholders will be entitled to a free introductory massage in the gym's massage parlour.

For a more leisurely approach to exercise, you might wish to book a lane in our ten-pin bowling centre. The latest computerised scoring machines will save you the trouble of adding up the figures and counting the strikes. Special bowling shoes are available from the lobby. Bowling balls in a range of sizes and weights are available, but you welcome to bring your own. 'Al's Late Night Diner' is open until 11pm Monday-Friday serving burgers, shakes and other typical American snacks for hungry bowlers. Tables may be booked in advanced and this is strongly advised for Thursday evening's team competitions. An Annual Bowling Card will ensure priority booking for lanes and free bowling shoe hire throughout the year.

UP HELLY AA

Possibly the oldest fire festival in Europe, Up Helly Aa takes **3.1** ____ every year on the Shetlands Islands in the north of Scotland to symbolise the end of Yule, or Christmas. There are small parties all over the islands, but the biggest and **3.2** ____ known is the one in Lerwick. It starts with a procession of men dressed as Vikings carrying lit torches down the main street, which is a reminder that this part of Scotland was **3.3** ____ the rule of Norse kings for several centuries. The tradition dates back to the late 19th century, but it is based on an earlier custom of pulling sledges filled with burning tar through the town. The torches **3.4** ____ carried into the market square, where there is a large fire waiting to be lit, on top of which is a replica of a Viking longship. The torches are then thrown into the ship and **3.5** ____ claps and cheers as it burns brightly throughout the evening. After this main event, groups of Vikings go off to parties which last all night long.
