4. In picture A, there are three on the table, but in picture B, there two books.

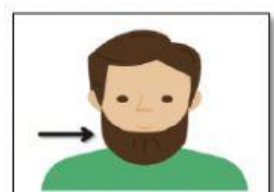
II. Find the different ones

 are places. But is not a place.



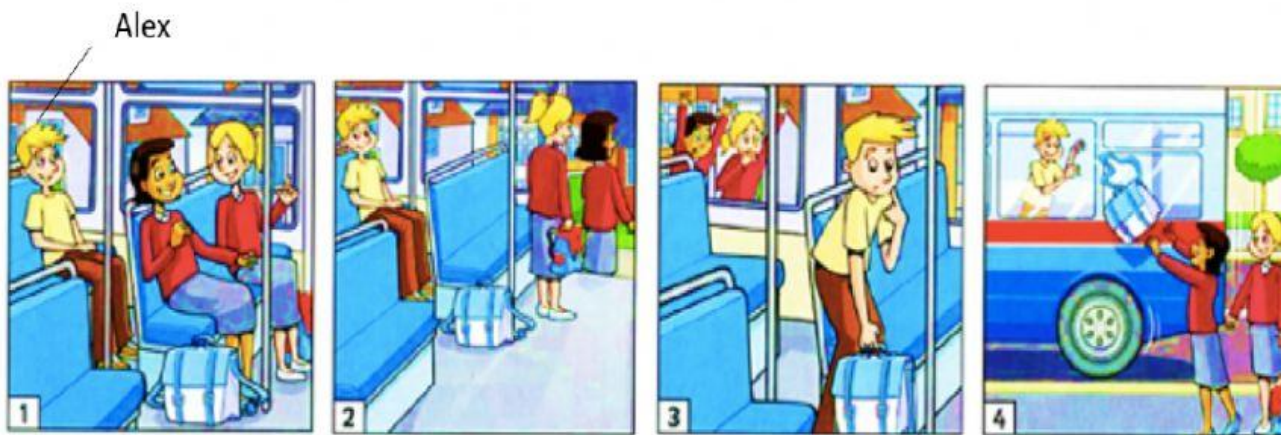
3. Picture is different because she's got hair.
