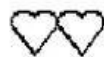


Likes and dislikes

...to express your taste :

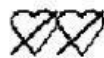


I like / enjoy

I prefer I'm crazy about



I hate / I can't stand / I can't bear

Neutral expression: *I don't mind ...*

GRAMMAR : like + verbe: aimer faire qqch

UK : verbe de goût + verbe-ing

US: verbe de goût + to + BV

IMPORTANT :

Enjoy et les expressions de goût avec le verbe être (to be fond of, to be keen on, to be crazy about) **sont toujours suivies de verbe-ing**, jamais de to + BV
