We use **Do** or **Does** to make a question in the simple present tense. *

* Exceptions: Questions with To Be and Modal Verbs (can, might, should etc.)

Auxiliary	Subject	Verb **
DO	I / you / we / they	go ... ?
DOES	he / she / it	want ... ?
		like ... ?

Affirmative: You speak English.
Question: **Do** you speak English?

Affirmative: He speaks English.
Question: **Does** he speak English?

** The base form of the infinitive = to go, to need, to speak, to live
Look: Third person verbs lose the final "s" in questions

Subject	Present Form Do**
I, You, We, You, They	do
He, She, It	does

Sentence	Question
I put the keys on the table.	Do I put the keys on the table?
She gets up early in mornings.	Does she get up early in mornings?
Coffee grows in Brazil.	Does coffee grow in Brazil?
You like spend time at home.	Do you like spend time at home?
