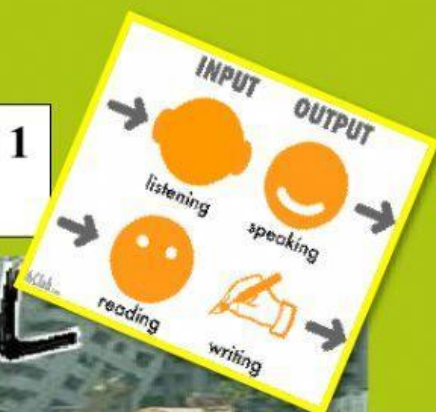

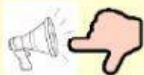

A natural disaster is a major catastrophic event caused by natural processes of the Earth.

The strongest earthquake in the country that has been measured was on December 12, 1979. It happened in the Pacific Ocean on the border between Ecuador and Colombia and measured 8.2 on the Richter scale.

It caused a tsunami, which is another type of natural disaster. It is a long high wave that can cause a lot of destruction. Some of the most famous volcanoes of these are the Cotopaxi, Reventador, Cayambe, and Tungurahua. Volcanoes can be erupting, active, dormant (not active but may be in the future), or extinct (has not erupted in over 10,000 years).
