

Introduction to Scratch

Sound blocks

Sound blocks are the blocks that control sound. There are 9 Sound blocks in Scratch 3.0.

Scratch 3.0 has the following eight Sound Stack blocks:

-  — The **start sound** block starts a sound and continues the script. The **play sound until done** block plays a sound and pauses the script until it finishes. The **stop all sounds** block stops all sounds. The **change volume by** block changes the volume by a specified amount. The **set volume to** block sets the volume to a specified percentage. The **change pitch or effect by** block changes the pitch or effect by a specified amount. The **set pan left/right or effect to** block sets the pan left/right or effect to a specified amount. The **clear sound effects** block clears all sound effects.

Scratch 3.0 has the following Sound Reporter block:

-  — The **volume** block returns the volume.
