Who	speaks English? lives in Italy?

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Auxiliary + **Subject** + **Verb + ING**

Wh- questions			
Where		I	workING now?
		he / she / it	
		you /we / they	

Question Word + **Auxiliary** + **Subject** + **Verb + ING**

Subject Questions	
Who	is workING now?

PRESENT PERFECT

Yes / No questions		
	I / you /we / they	BEEN to Italy?
	he / she / it	

Auxiliary + **Subject** + **Verb Past Participle (3rd column)**

Wh- questions			
Where		I / you /we / they	BEEN?
		he / she / it	

Question Word + **Auxiliary** + **Subject** + **Verb Past Participle**

Subject Questions	
Who	HAS BEEN in Italy?
