



Sand Sculptures



In 2006, in the seaside town of Weston-super-Mare, in England, an amazing sand sculpture of King Kong ¹ *was produced* (produce) by two Dutch sculptors. How to make a sand sculpture

Wet sand ⁷ (use) to make the sand sculptures. Water ⁸ (pour) onto the sand, and then the wet sand ⁹ (press) down to remove all the air. Finally, the sand ¹⁰ (form) into the right shape.
