

Generally, a movie r\_\_\_\_\_w is a genre of art criticism and j\_\_\_\_\_m.  
It is a complex overview, usually made by a p\_\_\_\_\_l critic, on films  
that have just b\_\_\_\_\_n released, to help decide what film to watch.

Professional reviews d\_\_\_\_\_r from those made by a\_\_\_\_\_s; they are  
more structured, sharper, more d\_\_\_\_\_d, but at the same time more  
compact in wording. In a professional movie review you will always find  
a\_\_\_\_\_s of the film's director(s), their p\_\_\_\_\_s works and  
previous filmmaker's pictures, as well as a deep u\_\_\_\_\_g of different  
film genres and classics for each of them, and filming t\_\_\_\_\_s and  
modern trends.

Though, you can find a lot of reviews that are made by ordinary movie fans  
— and sometimes they can end up being more i\_\_\_\_\_e and useful than  
a professional one.
