a donut.



BAD - WORSE

My boss is
worse than
your boss.



FAR - FARTHER

Your school is
farther than
my school.

USE **MORE** WITH ADJECTIVES THAT HAVE TWO OR MORE SYLLABLES.



HANDSOME - **MORE** HANDSOME

My English teacher is **more handsome than** my math teacher.



DELICIOUS - **MORE** DELICIOUS

I think the hamburger is **more delicious than** the pizza.



HOSPITABLE - **MORE** HOSPITABLE

The Ritz Hotel is **more hospitable than** the Boston Hotel.



FRIENDLY - **FRIENDLIER**

The new girl is **friendlier than** Ruth.

RULE 2

ENDING ER



IF AN ADJECTIVE ENDS IN "Y":
DELETE THE "Y" • SUBSTITUTE IT WITH AN "I" • ADD ER



PRETTY - PRETT**IER**

Mary is
prettier than
Jane.



LAZY - LAZ**IER**

My neighbor's cat is
lazier than
my cat.



HEAVY - HEAV**IER**

That box is
heavier than
this box.



NOISY - NOIS**IER**

Main Street is
noisier than
Third Street.

SPELLING



IF AN ADJECTIVE HAS **ONE SYLLABLE**, AND IT HAS **ONE CONSONANT • ONE VOWEL • ONE CONSONANT**,
DOUBLE THE CONSONANT AND ADD ER.



BIG - BIGGER

My dad's bike is
bigger than
my bike.



HOT - HOTTER

Your soup is
hotter than
my soup.



MEAN - MEANER

Cooper is
meaner than
Duke.

RULE 1

ENDING ER



ADD **ER** TO ADJECTIVES THAT HAVE
ONE SYLLABLE.



SMALL - SMALL**ER**

My car is
smaller than
your car.



TALL - TALL**ER**

Bob is
taller than
Mike.



FAST - FAST**ER**

Max is
faster than
Buddy.



CLEAN - CLEAN**ER**

Your house is
cleaner than
my house.
