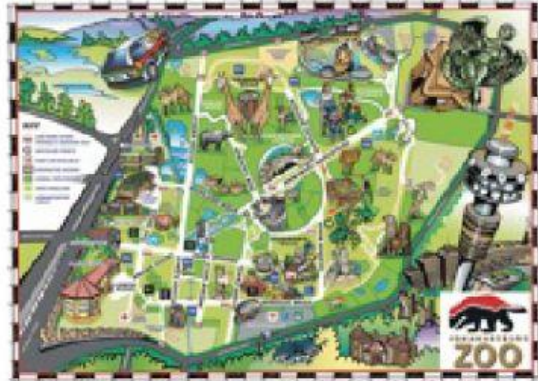


A Trip to the Zoo
