Lesser Rock Frog

Physical Characteristics: The lesser rock frog is a small frog. A male can grow up 30mm long.

A female can grow up to 55mm long. This frog has long legs with webbed feet. Its green and brown colour helps it to camouflage with rocks and hide from danger when it is perching on rocks. It breathes through its skin, not through its mouth.

Habitat: This frog lives in rocky rainforest streams and waterfalls.

Diet: The lesser rock frog eats insects like crickets.

Behaviour: This frog lifts its back leg and waves when it wants to talk to its friends. It lays its eggs in streams. The lesser rock frog rests during the day and looks for food at night.

Dangers: The lesser rock frog is an endangered frog. There are only a small number of these frogs living in Borneo. When people throw rubbish into rivers and streams, they become polluted. The lesser rock frogs might get sick. We must look after their habitat.
