

LANDFORMS

Landforms are natural features of the Earth's surface.

Two main types of landforms: **inland** and **coastal**.

INLAND LANDSCAPES

MOUNTAINS

: Large inclines of rocky land that rise from the ground.

The top of the mountain: summit.

The bottom of the mountain: foot.

A row of mountains: mountain range.



HILLS

: Small, rounded elevations of land.



PLATEAUS

: large, high areas of flat land located more than 600 meters above sea level.



PLAINS

: wide, flat stretches of land.



VALLEYS

: areas of low-lying land between mountains or hills.
