

Solve these word problems.

Sharon and Paul are baking cupcakes for a summer cake sale. Sharon bakes 160 cakes and Paul bakes 150 cakes. How many did they bake in total?

A theatre sells 168 tickets on Saturday and 184 tickets on Sunday. How many did they sell on that weekend?

Brian has gone travelling. One day he drives 177 miles and the next day he drives 155 miles. How many miles has he travelled altogether?

Michelle is collecting stamps, she has 140 stamps in total. She gives 88 stamps to another collector. How many stamps does Michelle have left?

There are 178 red and yellow flowers in the garden. 98 flowers are red. How many are yellow?

Janet has started a business. In the first week she sells \$161 of goods, the second week she sells \$191. What is the overall sales?

There are 130 boxes of chocolate in a supermarket. Before the Hari Raya festival, 112 boxes are bought by shoppers. How many are left after Hari Raya?

In a school, there are 726 children in total in Year 3 and Year 4. 214 children are in Year 3. How many children are in Year 4?

Paul is sprinting and sprints 163 metres. After 1 minute, he sprinted 130 metres. How many metres are left?

Allan and Marin play hockey together each weekend. Across the course of their careers, Allan has scored 178 goals and Marin has scored 196. What is their combined scores?
