- Hecate commands they make sure Macbeth feels safe.
- Macbeth's guests are shocked by Macbeth's reaction, as they can't see the ghost.
- Banquo and Fleance are attacked on their way to Macbeth's castle.
- Lady Macbeth asks the guests to leave.
- Macbeth fears his power is at risk if an heir of Banquo is alive.
