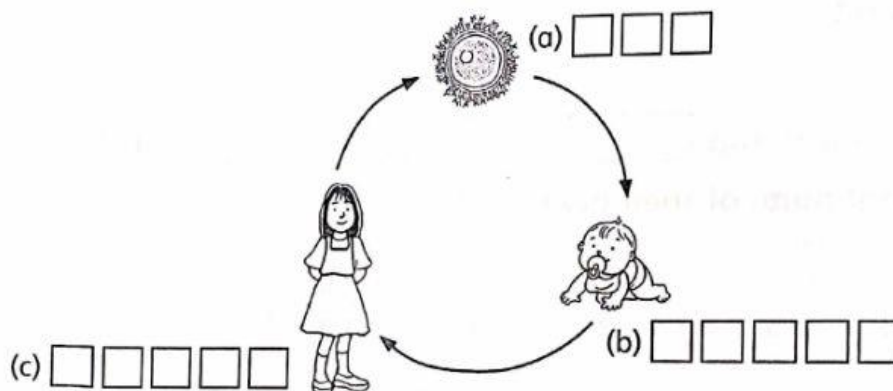

8. The life cycle of a human consists of three stages. They are the egg, young and adult stages.



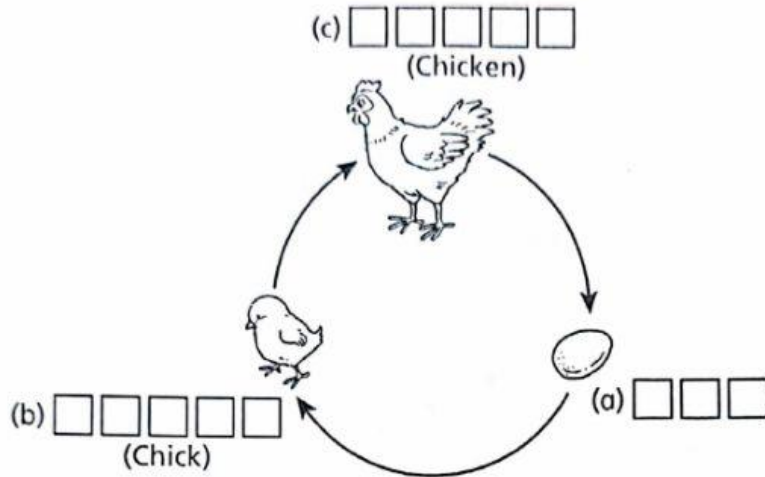
9. A fertilised egg develops into a foetus inside the mother's  until it is ready to be born.

## 1.2 Stages in the life cycles of some animals

### Life cycle of a chicken

1. The life cycle of a chicken consists of three stages. They are the egg, young and adult stages.



2. The eggs of a chicken are laid on .
3. A hen incubates the eggs by sitting on them to provide them with .
4. Each egg has a  shell to protect the developing chick in it.
5. The egg yolk provides the developing chick with  and the chick will hatch from the egg three weeks after the egg was laid.
