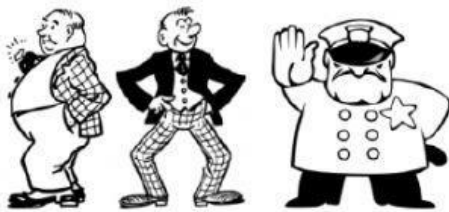

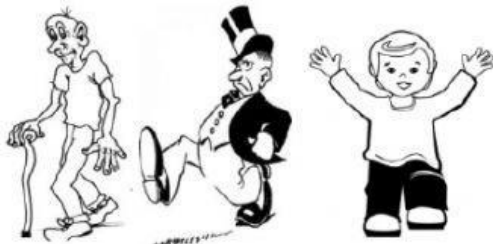

John is the (young)

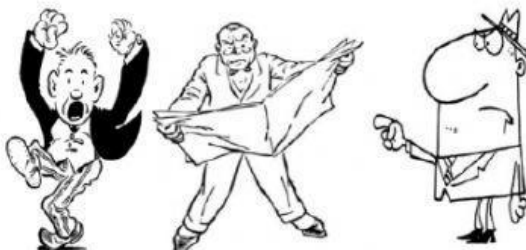


Cheetah

The cheetah is the(fast)

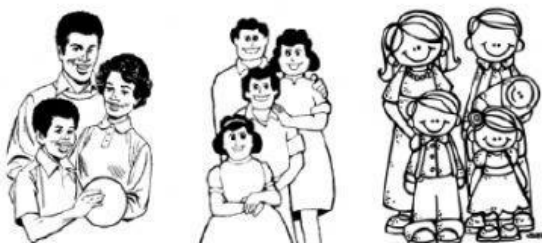


Sam
