a holiday that includes everything: the flight, hotel, meals, etc.

an official document or a stamp in your passport which allows you to enter or leave a particular country.

if you have an "overnight stay", you sleep in a hotel during your journey.

a place with hotels / restaurants, etc. where people spend their holidays: a beach resort / a ski resort.

the place in an airport where customs officials may check your bags for drugs / weapons, etc.

a bed in a hotel with breakfast included.

when you go on a "journey", you travel somewhere. Typical expressions include: *car journey / train journey / long journey / short journey...*

the rate at which one currency can be exchanged for another. For example, the exchange rate for euros to dollars.

if someone takes you on a "guided tour", they show you around a place of interest and tell you all about it.
