Yet => Up to a specified time; thus far. It is used in questions and negatives.

Yet usually comes at the end of the sentence.

Ex: Have you finished your homework yet?

I haven't finished it yet.

Already => It is used to say that something has happened early - or earlier than it might have happened. 'Already' usually comes in mid-position.

Ex: I've already spent my salary.
