Choose either the Present Perfect or the Past Simple to go into each sentence:

1. We (go) to the restaurant last night.
2. I (not / be) there for ages.
3. Hector (spend) his last summer holiday in the country.
4. Charlotte (not / arrive) yet.
5. I (earn) a lot of money last month.
6. The kids (visit) their grandparents two days ago.
7. You (tell) me about it already.
8. I (read) over 7 books this month.
9. We (discuss) that problem many weeks ago.
10. Here are your shoes. I (just/clean) them.

Put the verbs into the correct tense (Past Simple or Present Perfect):

A: (you / taste / ever) sushi?

B: Yes, I (eat) sushi at least five times so far.



A: When (you / eat) sushi for the first time?

B: I (eat) sushi for the first time on my dad's 50th birthday. He (invite) the whole family to a Japanese restaurant.

A: (you / like) it?

B: Absolutely. In fact, it (be) so good that we (be) to that restaurant three times yet. And on my mum's birthday, we (order) some sushi and (have) it at home.
