

In recent years, video games have become a topic of debate in the media. Are videogames dangerous? Are they addictive? Can they cause violent behavior in players? These are some of the questions that were asked in some recent newspaper and magazine articles. Many of the articles written about video games tell horror stories of teenage players who stare at screens for

hours, days, or even weeks at a time. They say that these teenagers do not study and hardly stop to eat or sleep. According to the articles, teenagers who play lots of video games are very antisocial. Some parents and teachers have claimed that video games can ruin lives, just like drugs and tobacco. But is this fake news? Are these worries justified? Gaming is a very popular hobby and there are millions of people all around the world who play. All of these people can't be unfortunate addicts and loners, can they? To investigate this issue, our online journal contacted Stephen Humphrey, the chairman of the University of Northern Washington's Video Game and Robotics Club. Humphrey told us that out of a total of 248 students who are registered in the club, 245 of them have passing grades. That means that only 3 students are failing their classes. He also told us that about 75% of the students participate in other extracurricular activities and clubs such as sports, drama, art, music and language. Humphrey told us that there are several members of his club that may play video games a bit too much. However, he reassured us that this behavior of extreme addiction is the minority.
