

These are easy!

1. Multiply the whole number by the fraction's denominator (bottom number)

2. Add that to the numerator (top number) and rewrite the fraction.



1.  $2 \frac{3}{4} = \frac{11}{4}$  ( 2 times 4 is 8. Add the 8 to the 3 to make 11.)
