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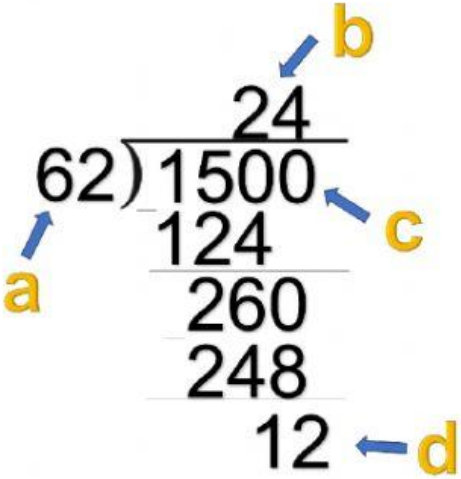

 The image shows a long division problem: 62 into 1500. The quotient is 24 with a remainder of 12. The steps are: 62 goes into 150 two times (124), leaving a remainder of 26. Bring down the next 0 to get 260. 62 goes into 260 four times (248), leaving a remainder of 12. The labels are: 'a' points to the divisor 62, 'b' points to the first part of the quotient 24, 'c' points to the first subtraction step (150 - 124), and 'd' points to the final remainder 12.	A=
