## The second man on the moon

Buzz Aldrin <sup>was</sup> born Edwin Eugene Aldrin, Jr. on January 20, 1930 and <sup>was</sup> in New Jersey, U.S. After he <sup>attended</sup> high school, he <sup>went</sup> to college and later studied for a PhD at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Then he <sup>found</sup> a job – as an astronaut with NASA. In 1969, he was the second person to walk on the moon. He left his job at NASA in 1971, after a total of 289 hours and 53 minutes in space. He <sup>later</sup> married three times and he <sup>has</sup> three children: two sons and a daughter.
