Descriptive Writing Steps

A descriptive story tells about a person, place, thing or an idea. It should ideally have words that help a reader to see, hear, feel, taste and smell what is being described.

1. Introduction: Grab the readers attention, tell what happened, where it happened, who was there
2. Body Descriptive details (what did you hear, see, feel, taste, smell)
3. Conclusion: summarize, share your feelings or opinion
