



AS

1. **As** is used to show the result of a particular situation.

EXAMPLE

- I did not give my younger brother my soft toy. He cried.

My younger brother cried as

Result

I did not give him my soft toy.

Situation

(The reason why my younger brother cried is that I did not give him my soft toy.)



NOTE: **As** is always written before the situation. You can begin a sentence with **as** if you follow this rule.

2. **As** is also used to show that two actions or events are happening at the same time.

EXAMPLE

- I was bathing. I was also singing happily.

I was singing happily as I was bathing.

(I was bathing and, at the same time, I was singing happily.)

- He is reading *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix*. He is eating his burger at the same time.

He is reading *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix* as he eats his burger.

(He is reading *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix* and eating a burger at the same time.)



NOTE: When you are given two sentences where the verbs are given in a continuous form, you have to change the verb in the second sentence into simple present tense when you use **as**.

He is reading *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix*.
Present continuous

He is eating his burger.
Present continuous

He is reading *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix* **as** he eats his burger.
Simple present
