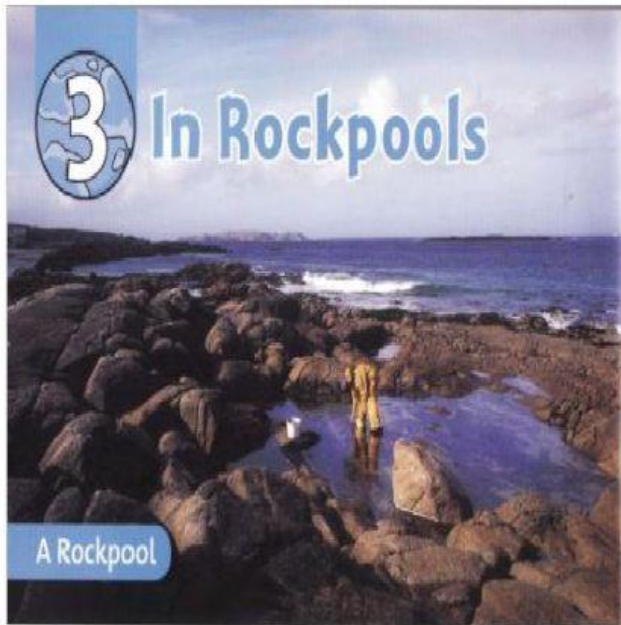


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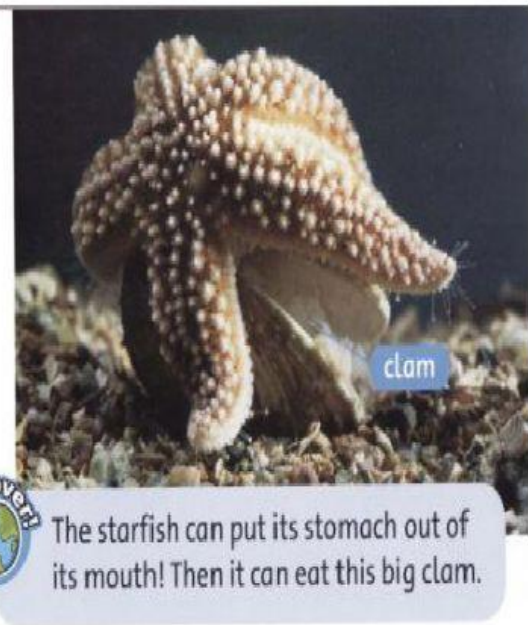
Class:



At low tide, the ocean moves down the beach. Then you can find rockpools.

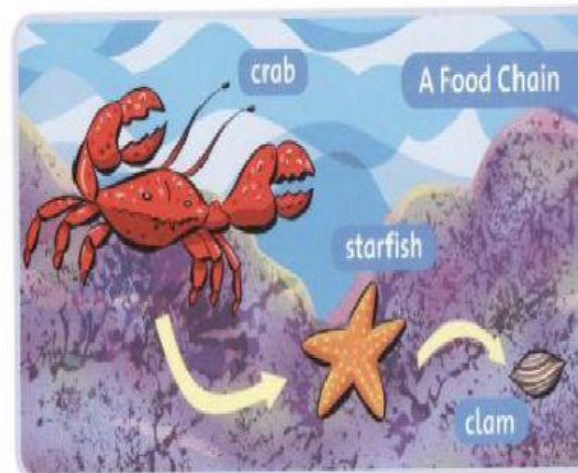


Let's look in a rockpool. Here's a crab. It gets food with its big, strong claws. It eats barnacles, starfish, and other little animals. It eats plants, too.



The starfish can put its stomach out of its mouth! Then it can eat this big clam.

Crabs eat starfish, and starfish eat clams. This is called a food chain.
