**Economic sectors**

There are three main economic sectors. They are called the primary, the secondary and the tertiary sectors. These sectors make a chain of production which provide customers with goods and services.



**The primary sector**

Workers in the primary sector get the materials we need to make things. These are called raw materials. People work in agriculture, fishing, mining and forestry. Agriculture is important because farmers produce crops like wheat, fruit and vegetables. They also keep animals for meat and sheep for wool. The forestry industry cuts down trees for wood, and mining means digging coal or other minerals out of the ground or oil from the sea.



**The secondary sector**

People in the secondary sector take the raw materials and change or make them into things that people can use. Most of these products are made in factories. For example, clothes are made from cotton or wool, furniture from wood and cars from metal. Coal is used to supply us with the energy we need for our homes.



**The tertiary sector**

The tertiary sector is a very large sector. It is also called the service sector because the people who work in this sector provide a service. For example, hairdressers and teachers work in the tertiary sector as they are providing a service. At a hospital, the doctors, nurses and scientists who are employed there provide a health service.
