

Present Perfect Simple Passive:

has/have been + past participle



Subject Verb Object Subject Verb Agent
 Rebecca has cleaned her room. → Rebecca's room has been cleaned (by her).

S V O S V A
 Steve hasn't bought a new car. → A new car hasn't been bought by Steve.

S V O S V A
 Have they arranged the seats? → Have the seats been arranged (by them)?
