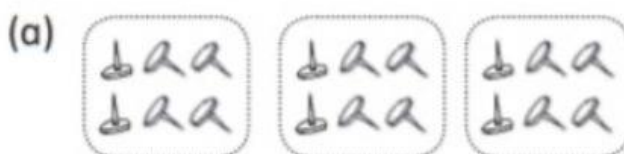




## Multiplication Tables of 6, 7, 8 and 9

### Practice 1 Multiplying 6: Skip-counting

1. Look at the pictures.  
Fill in the blanks.



$$3 \times 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

Multiply 6 by 3.

$$6 \times 3 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$



$$4 \times 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

Multiply 6 by 4.

$$6 \times 4 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$



$$5 \times 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

Multiply 6 by 5.

$$6 \times 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$
