# Comparative

Adjectives with one syllable, add: '-er' or '-r' + 'than'	<b>cold</b> "In Canada, winter is <u>colder</u> <u>than</u> summer."
Adjectives with two syllables that end in '-y', change '-y' to 'i' and add: '-er' + 'than'	<b>hap-py</b> "John is <u>happier</u> <u>than</u> David."
Adjectives with two or more syllables, add: 'more' + 'than'	<b>ex-pen-sive</b> "This book is <u>more</u> expensive <u>than</u> that book."
Adjectives that end in a single vowel and consonant:  double the final letter before adding 'than'	<b>big</b> "Russia is <u>bigger</u> <u>than</u> Canada."
Irregular Comparative Adjectives:	<b>good</b> - better than  <b>bad</b> - worse than  <b>far</b> - farther than further than

# Superlatives

Adjectives with one syllable, add: <b>'the' + '-est' (or '-st')</b>	<b>cold</b> "January is often the coldest winter month."
Adjectives with two syllables that end in '-y', change '-y' to 'i' and add: <b>'the' + '-est' (or '-st')</b>	<b>hap-py</b> "John is the happiest person I know."
Adjectives with two or more syllables, add: <b>'the' + 'most'</b>	<b>ex-pen-sive</b> "This book is the most expensive book in the store."
Adjectives that end in a single vowel and consonant: <b>double the final letter</b> before adding <b>'the' + '-est' (or '-st')</b>	<b>big</b> "Brazil is the biggest country in South America."
Irregular Superlative Adjectives:	<b>good</b> - the best <b>bad</b> - the worst <b>far</b> - the farthest






# Countable and uncountable nouns



<b>Positive</b>	There is an Apple. There is some milk.	There are apples.
<b>Negative</b>	There isn't an Apple. There isn't any milk.	There aren't apples.
<b>Interrogative</b>	Is there an Apple? Is there any milk?	Are there apples?

## Examples:

- There is some sugar.
- There isn't any sugar.
- There are some bananas.
- There aren't any bananas.
- There is an onion.
- There isn't an onion.

# Countable and uncountable nouns

- **A/an** + singular countable nouns.
  - Examples:
  - There is a banana in the kitchen.
  - There is an orange in the fridge.
- **Some** + 
 

{	Plural countable nouns.
{	Uncountable nouns.



Examples:

- There is some water in the bottle.
  - There is some sugar in the kitchen.
  - There are some bananas.

- **Any**

{	Countable nouns in questions and negatives.
{	Uncountable nouns in questions.

Examples:

- Are there any oranges in the fridge?
- No, there isn't.
- Is there any coffee in the kitchen?
- No, there isn't any coffee in the kitchen.
