

# Present Progressive and Present Simple

The present simple is used to talk about facts, or things that happen over and over again.

Ex: They have a big house. She runs every morning. They travel to Spain every summer.

The present progressive is used to talk about things happening right now.

Ex: She is wearing a red dress. They are eating lunch now. He is running at the moment.
