The sleepy lizard (*tiliqua rugosa*)

Description

- They are common in Western and South Australia
- They are brown, but recognisable by their blue 31
- They are relatively large
- Their diet consists mainly of 32
- Their main predators are large birds and 33

Navigation study

- One study found that lizards can use the 34 to help them navigate

Observations in the wild

- Observations show that these lizards keep the same 35 for several years

What people want

- Possible reasons:
 - to improve the survival of their young
(but little 36 has been noted between parents and children)
 - to provide 37 for female lizards

Tracking study

- A study was carried out using GPS systems attached to the 38 of the lizards
- This provided information on the lizards' location and even the number of 39 taken
- It appeared that the lizards were trying to avoid one another
- This may be in order to reduce chances of 40
