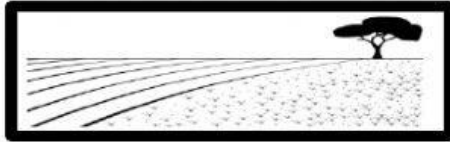

A new pupil comes to school and they dress differently than you. You don't like their outfit, but you keep your opinions to yourself.

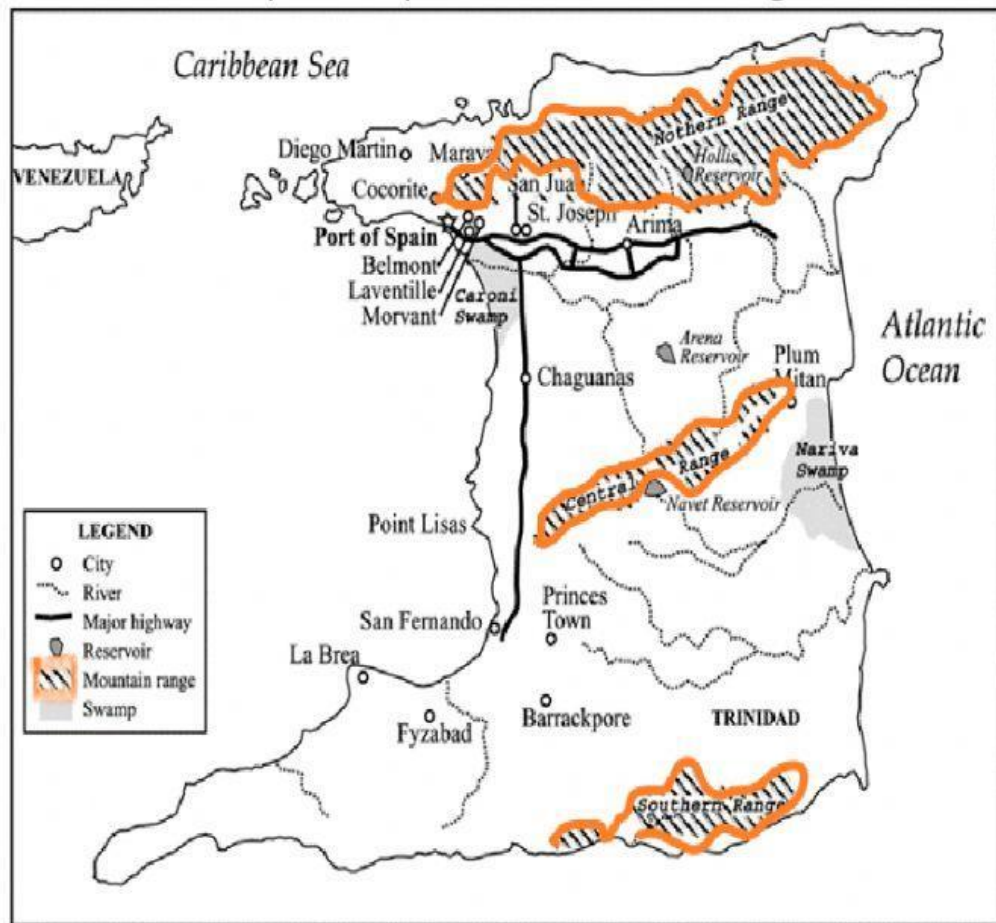
Not respectful- When you call someone names, you are not considering their feelings. You can tell someone you are upset without being mean.
