

PAST SIMPLE – REGULAR VERBS

El pasado en inglés se puede dividir en:

- Verbos regulares (todos se construyen de la misma manera)
- Verbos irregulares (el pasado de estos verbos hay que estudiarlos uno a uno porque son distintos).

En esta unidad solo estudiaremos como se construyen los **verbos regulares**, es muy fácil. Simplemente tenemos **que AÑADIR -ED AL FINAL DEL VERBO**. Existen excepciones como siempre hemos aprendido pero en este caso, nos centraremos solo en los verbos de la tabla:

Start- Started	Play - Played	Open- Opened	Dance- Danced
Watch-Watched	Brush- Brushed	Answer- Answered	Ask- Asked
Cook- Cooked	Close- Closed	Finish- Finished	Help-Helped
Like- Liked	Look/ looked	Talk- Talked	Use- Used
Visit- Visited	Wait- Waited	Want- Wanted	Walk- Walked

Examples:

- Yesterday I visited my grandmother.
- When I was a child I played basketball.
- Yesterday I played the guitar.

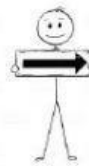
